Academics

Father McGivney Catholic High School is fully accredited with AdvancEd, is fully recognized by the Illinois State Board of Education, and is a member of the National Catholic Education Association and the Illinois High School Association.

The standard school day consists of nine periods. Graduates earn a high school diploma and may also achieve a college preparatory diploma by successfully completing an extra year of foreign language and an extra elective course. There are over 35 course offerings from which students may choose in disciplines of English, Fine Arts, Foreign Language, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies/Social Sciences, and Theology and include Honors, Dual Credit, and Advanced Placement courses.

It is important to Father McGivney Catholic High School that we prepare our students for the future...and the future is technology. Each classroom in our new, high-tech facility is equipped with a large, flat-screen television, state-of-the-art sound system, the ability for teachers to project their interactive classroom instruction onto the television, and there is wireless technology throughout the building.

Father McGivney Catholic High School is a 1:1 laptop school and is the only one in the Diocese of Springfield, Illinois. Each student receives a laptop with e-textbooks on the first day and the laptop is theirs to keep after graduating from McGivney. E-textbooks are designed to be a more interactive option than the standard textbook, providing a greater resource for the students to learn from and offering different learning styles right at the student's fingertips. The only physical book our students carry is their Bible. As an enhancement to e-books, Father McGivney teachers use Moodle in their classrooms for instruction, assignments, quizzes and tests.
